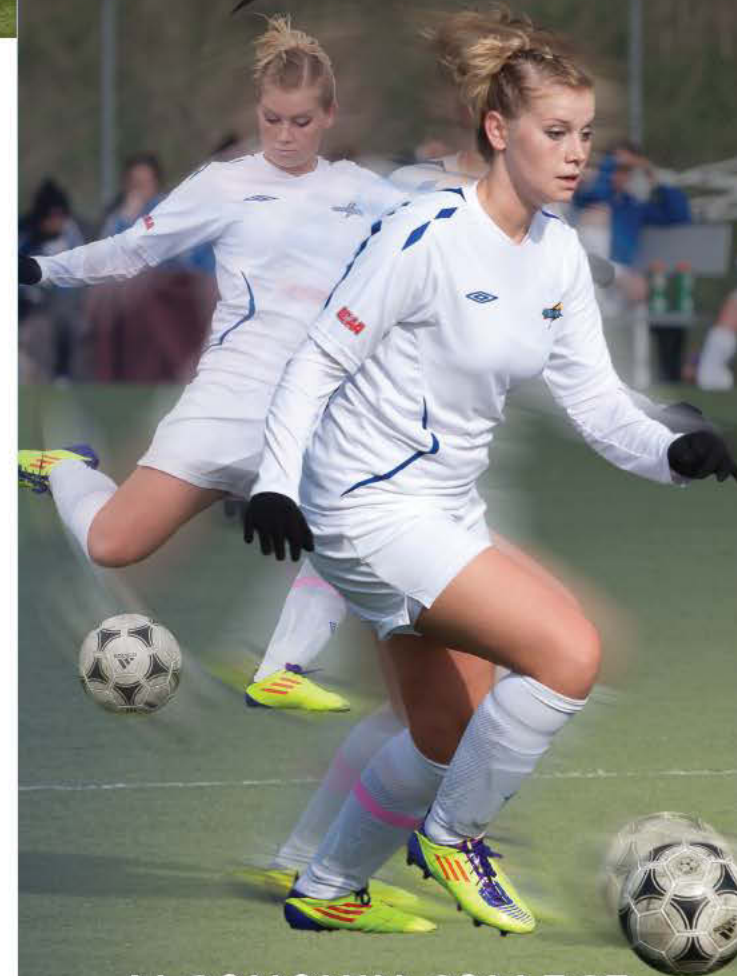

The College season is relatively short with a minimal number of pre-season games and 10 regular season games before playoffs. We have three training sessions per week.
