

[GP01] Governance Commitment

The purpose of governance is that the Board, on behalf of Activity Fee-paying students, guarantees the accountability of the Students' Association of The Algonquin College of Applied Arts and Technology Corporation (the Students' Association) by assuring that it (a) achieves appropriate results with the appropriate persons at an appropriate cost, and (b) avoids unacceptable activities, conditions, and decisions. In fulfillment of the charge, the Board of Directors is committed to rigorous and continual improvement of its capabilities to define values and visions.

1. To ensure accountability to activity fee-paying students, the Board will formally review the demographic profile of the membership on all campuses in the first three months of its term each year.
2. Directors are expected to commit a minimum of forty (40) hours per month.
3. Implementation of the Governance Process and all policies stated herein are in effect as of May 25, 1995.
